

**LEAD & COPPER RULE
CORROSION CONTROL VIOLATION NOTICE
MANDATORY LANGUAGE – TIER III**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Klondike ISD has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have the right to know what happened and what we are doing to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During 07/01/2021 to 12/31/2021, we did not monitor for lead and copper and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

The table below lists the contaminants we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for the contaminants, how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken and the date on which follow up samples were taken.

Contaminant	Required sampling frequency	Number of samples taken	When samples should have been taken	When samples were taken
Lead & Copper	Once every six months	0	July 1, 2021 to Dec. 31, 2021	May 2022

What is being done?

We have changed out all the old drinking fountains and replaced them with new fountains that do not contain lead or copper pipes. We have ran RO water to nearly all drinking fountains. We have a kiosk located at the front of the school that supplies RO water to all people that want it. We are in the process of researching to see if the supply lines to the drinking fountains are lead or copper. We are also in the process of doing a Corrosion Control Study.
