

# Dual Credit Agreement

- Parent and/or legal guardian are responsible for paying tuition for dual credit class or classes. Failure to pay tuition on time will cause you to be dropped from the class or classes. If you are dropped from a class, there is no guarantee you can get back into the class.
- Text books are to be purchased by the student; there will not be a reimbursement for textbooks.
- Students need to be aware they are responsible for all work and deadlines in accordance to the syllabus and must adhere to all rules and regulations.
- If a student wants to drop a class, they must first be granted permission. They will then be placed in a KHS class that is equal to the course in which they are enrolled, and current dual credit grades will follow.
- To receive high school credit, you must pass the class or classes with a grade of 70 or above.
- Class or classes that are a state requirement must be taken prior to the spring semester of your senior year.
- High school credit will not be awarded for a college course unless it is taken at KHS and proctored by a staff member.
