



Private Non-Profit Equitable Services

School districts that receive federal funds are required to provide equitable services for eligible school children, teachers, and other educational personnel at registered private non-profit schools that desire to participate.

Private school equitable services refers to the process of providing students, teachers, staff, and families at eligible private schools, fair access to federally funded education programs and services, as appropriate. Resources for required equitable services for Private/Non Profit organizations as allowed under federal grants could be provided if you are a Private Non-Profit organization. Educational services or other benefits, including materials and equipment, provided under this section, shall be secular, neutral, and non-ideological.

Among other requirements, the process depends on a “timely and meaningful consultation” between ISD officials and those of eligible PNPs.
