IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Our system failed to collect every required coliform sample. Although this incident was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we are doing to correct this situation. We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During 06/01/2024 to 06/30/2024 we did not test for coliform bacteria and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other actions. We do not have coliform in our water and we never have had coliform in our water.

What is being done?

While we did not notify the state as quickly as we should have, we are taking steps to make sure that this does not happen again.
